- (a) The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. Director, JIPMER reserves the right to vary the above vacancies as per requirements of the Institute or otherwise.
- (b) For posts listed at Sr. No. 1b, 4, 13a, 13b, 13c, 13d, 14b, 24, 29b: The selected candidates may be required to share the other clinical/teaching work in the department beyond the area indicated in the post name.
- (c) Horizontal Reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD): 5 backlog vacancies. The functional requirements and Benchmark Disability (BD) for each Department are mentioned in Annexure 1. The functional requirements and BD for (i) Geriatric Medicine will be the same as that for Medicine (ii) Laboratory Services will be same as that for Pathology and (iii) JISPH and Preventive Oncology will be the same as that for Preventive and Social Medicine.

- d) Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. (As per the Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019 dt 31st January 2019 by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances& Pension & F.No. A11013/01/2019 dt. 28th February 2019 by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India).

19. MODE OF SELECTION: Personal interview / Online by video conferencing
